WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Anyone unfamiliar with public transit and riding Mountain Line buses – first-time riders, experienced riders wanting to learn new routes, children and teens commuting to and from school, older adults, persons with disabilities, and those new to Flagstaff.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Travel training can be conducted for groups or individuals, and can be tailored to fit different schedules and needs. The travel trainer will use a combination of class time and hands-on instruction, which can be done at the Mountain Line Headquarters or off-site.
