
# Mountain Line Passenger Load Report July 2020

The following information is designed to help transit riders make informed decisions about traveling on our buses. If there is capacity to do so, Mountain Line relies on riders to social distance themselves while on the bus. The following passenger load allows people to have six feet of distance between themselves and others:

- 10 people for Routes 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 14, 66
- 17 people for Route 10

Mountain Line does not limit the number of people on a bus, so there may be times when social distancing of six feet is not possible.

The following ridership data is collected from the entire month.



The graph above describes an average number of people onboard the bus according to route. On average, all routes except Route 66 have less than or equal to 10 people on board at any given time. For instance, if you want to take Route 3 (green line) but want to choose a time that would allow social distancing, avoid 1pm.



This graph shows the maximum passenger load experienced over the month of July. Using the last example of Route 3, while on average 6am-12pm and 2-8pm are likely to have less than 10 people, every hour has experienced at least one day when more than 10 people were onboard.
