


Mountain Line Passenger Load Report - April 2021

The following information is designed to help transit riders make informed decisions about traveling on our buses. If there is capacity to do so, Mountain Line relies on riders to social distance themselves while on the bus. The following passenger load allows people to have six feet of distance between themselves and others:

- 10 people for a 35-foot bus (typically Routes 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 14, sometimes 10 & 66)
- 17 people for a 60-foot bus (typically Routes 10 & 66)

Mountain Line does not limit the number of people on a bus, so there may be times when social distancing of six feet is not possible.



The graph above describes an average number of people onboard the bus according to route. On average, all routes have less than 10 people on board at any given time. If you want to take Route 3 (green line) but want to choose a time that would allow social



distancing, this graph shows that Route 3 typically has always less than 5 people on the bus.



This graph shows the maximum passenger load experienced over the month of April. Using the example of route 5 (orange line), every hour except 2-4 pm has not experienced at least one day in the month when more than 15 people were onboard. If you want to maintain social distance on the bus while on Route 5, data show that 2-4 pm is the not the best time, as there is increased activity during those times.
