Northern Arizona Intergovernmental Public Transportation Authority (Mountain Line) intends to release a Request for Proposals for Kaspar Maintenance Facility CMAR (Construction Manager At Risk). The firm awarded is to assist Mountain Line and the Design Professional with demolition of an existing shop building and construction of a 21,000 SF maintenance facility located at 3773 Kaspar Drive, Flagstaff, Arizona. This procurement is expected to be released in October 2023, with project kickoff in January 2024 and project completion by December 2025.

Proposals will be submitted electronically as per the instructions in the RFP. Award shall be made with reasonable promptness by giving written notice to the Proposer whose proposal best conforms to the invitation and will be the most advantageous to Northern Arizona Intergovernmental Public Transportation Authority (Mountain Line). Other factors to be considered may include, but are not limited to, quality, uniformity of product, and Proposer's past performance on other contracts. Award may be made to other than the low-cost proposal. However, all proposals may be rejected if Mountain Line determines that rejection is in the public interest.
